

National Museum of Mathematics High School Internship Program

The National Museum of Mathematics (momath.org) is pleased to announce that the application period has opened for its Spring 2015 high school internship program. Open to all current high school students, the MoMath internship program will give participants the opportunity to:

- Interact with Museum visitors at MoMath by explaining and interpreting its cutting edge, engaging math exhibits.
- Improve interpersonal and communication skills.
- Explore mathematical concepts and share their love of math with others.
- Train with MoMath's experienced team of interpreters, managers, and museum directors.
- Learn valuable job skills.
- Include a unique experience on their college applications.

Details about the program:

- Interns will spend the majority of their time at MoMath on the Museum floor, interacting with visitors. Candidates must be personable, outgoing, and eager to engage with the general public, and they must be **enthusiastic about math!**
- While the majority of an intern's time will be spent on the Museum floor, interns may occasionally assist with back-of-house tasks in the Museum, in the retail shop, or at MoMath's administrative office.
- Prior volunteer or museum experience is desirable but not required.
- Interns must be willing to commit seven to eight hours per week, generally from 9:30 AM to 5:00 PM on a Saturday or a Sunday.
- Interns will be required to attend one 90-minute training session per month – generally occurring on Wednesday, Saturday, or Sunday mornings.
- The internship program will begin in January and run through June.

Please note that the high school internship program is highly selective; interested candidates will need to complete an application, provide transcripts and references, and have an in-person or video interview.
