On the ticket, visitors will write down their contact information and submit it into a giant bowl in the MoMath gift shop for a chance to win a spot in the exclusive VIP tour group. After the new year, Cindy Lawrence, Executive Director of MoMath, will draw the names of six winners who will experience an exclusive group tour of the Museum for themselves and two guests each.
