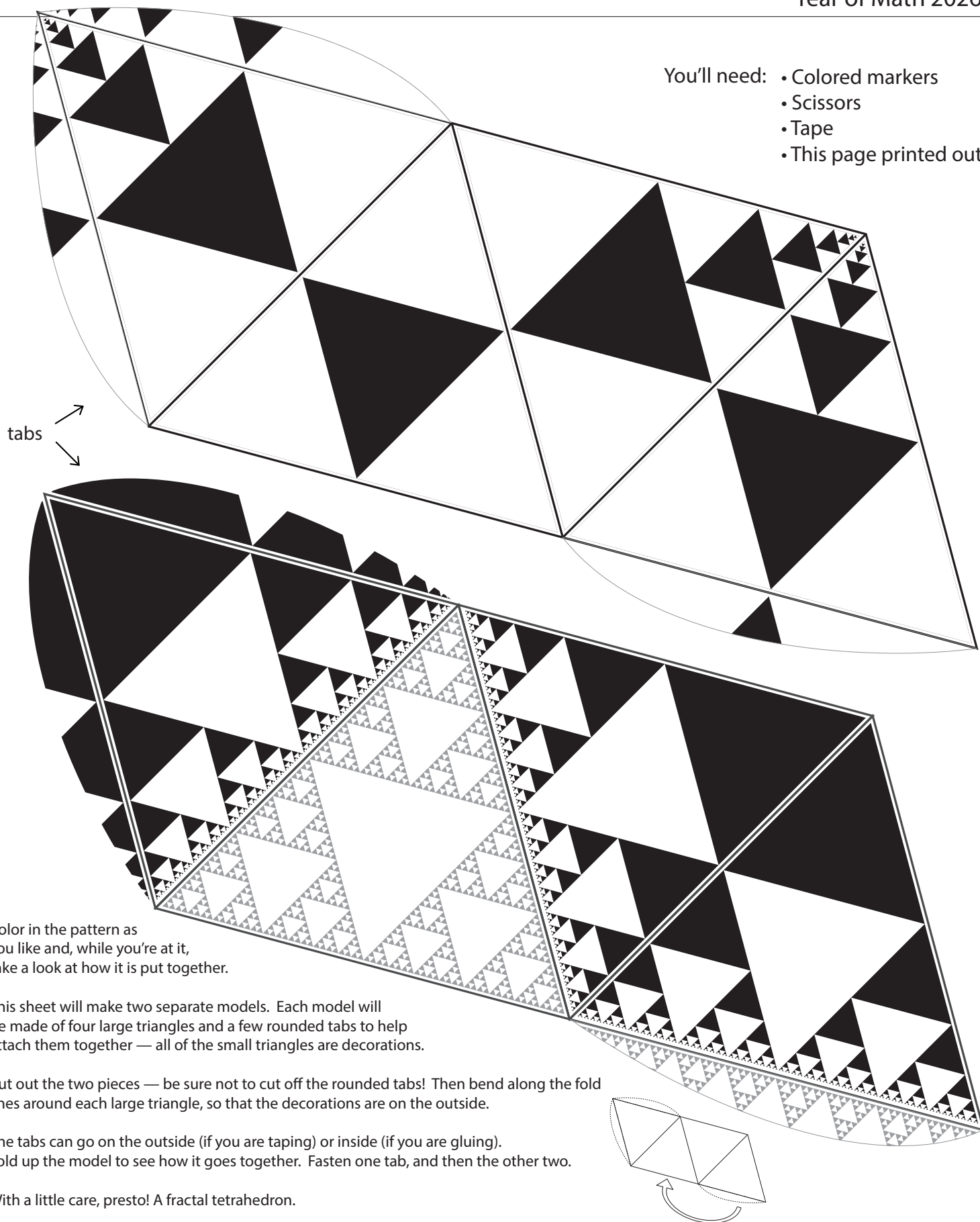


Two Fractal Tetrahedra

You'll need:

- Colored markers
- Scissors
- Tape
- This page printed out



Color in the pattern as you like and, while you're at it, take a look at how it is put together.

This sheet will make two separate models. Each model will be made of four large triangles and a few rounded tabs to help attach them together — all of the small triangles are decorations.

Cut out the two pieces — be sure not to cut off the rounded tabs! Then bend along the fold lines around each large triangle, so that the decorations are on the outside.

The tabs can go on the outside (if you are taping) or inside (if you are gluing). Fold up the model to see how it goes together. Fasten one tab, and then the other two.

With a little care, presto! A fractal tetrahedron.
